

AudioWrite Pro, from MicroBoards Technology, Inc. is the first CD Recordable system with both audio and data functionality. Users can install the AudioWrite Pro on their computer via the standard SCSI interface, and also connect the unit directly to any analog audio source, including tape decks, LP players or stereo console. No software is required to create customized audio CD's directly from an analog source. Simply begin the recording process by pressing the "Play" button on the analog deck, and "Record" on the AudioWrite Pro. The audio CD is created automatically on the fly, with no computer intervention. Users may connect the AudioWrite Pro to a PC or Macintosh, and burn audio, video or data CD's with conventional premastering/editing software. Customized audio discs utilizing MP3 files downloaded from the internet may also be created with the PlayWrite MP3 software provided with the unit. Most importantly, AudioWrite Pro uses standard 74" CD-R media. No proprietary media is required. Audiowrite Pro is designed to be the most versatile CD Recordable system for both audio and data applications.

Applications:

- Create compilation audio CD's (on the fly) directly from various analog sources including tape deck, LP player, radio, television, and others
- Connect to a PC and create compilation audio CD's by downloading MP3 audio files. Convert to a Red Book audio disc at once image using the PlayWrite MP3 software, and burn the CD on the AudioWrite Pro.
- Backup system data from your PC or Macintosh on CD-R. Long term data archival is provided by connecting the AudioWrite Pro to your system, and using conventional pre mastering software.
- Record an important event, or use for dictation, by connecting a microphone directly to the AudioWrite Pro RCA IN connectors on the back of the unit.
- Maintain audio fidelity and minimize noise introduction for audio tracks currently on tape or other magnetic source.
